PER COURT :

The applicant seeks to condone delay of 5490 days in presenting appeal for enhancement of compensation. For the reasons stated in the application, delay is sought to be condoned.

2. None appears for the contesting party, though served.
3. The learned A.G.P. opposes the application.
4. The averments of the application have not been controverted by the respondents/State. The applicants are ready to give up interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. There is no reason to infer any mala fides on the part of the applicant.
