. Applicant seeks to condone the delay of 6357 days caused in preferring the First appeal.

2. Learned AGP would oppose the application and the submission. None appears for respondent no.3 – contesting party.

3. The averments of the application have not been traversed by the respondents. Applicant is ready to give up the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. I find no oblique motive on the part of the applicant to prefer the appeal belatedly.
