PER COURT :-

1. Applicants are praying for condonation of delay of 3984 days in preferring first appeals.

2. For the reasons stated in the applications, delay is sought to be condoned. Applications are contested by learned AGP. It is submitted that no cogent evidence are assigned. The contents of the applications have not been traversed. There is no reason to infer any oblique motive on the part of the applicants. The applicants are ready to give up interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. It is desirable to

condone delay. The delay stands condoned on the condition that applicants shall not claim interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
