1. This is an application for condonation of delay of 2035 days caused in filing the application seeking restoration of cross objection alongwith civil application by setting aside the order dated 04.02.2020 passed by the Registrar and the applicant be permitted to remove the office objections within period of two weeks from the date of this order.
