PER COURT :

1. Today, applicant- Jayshree Sudarshan Boyane and non applicant - Sudarshan Vankat Boyane are personally present before this Court.

2. On 30.01.2026, this Court passed an order and referred the applicant and non applicant to the mediation. Accordingly, a trained Mediator Mr. Rahul R. Sancheti, who was appointed as Mediator and he has submitted his report dated 16.02.2026 stating that, the mediation is successful in terms of settlement and enclosed with the settlement report which reads as under :

3. The said mediation report alongwith terms and conditions are taken on record and marked as Exhibit- "X" for identification.

4. Since both the parties have amicably settled their dispute and decided to withdraw the counter cases lodged against each other as per the enclosure of the report, therefore, it would be just and proper to dispose of this application in terms of mediation report.
