1. Learned advocate Mr. Akshay Radikar submits that he has instructions to appear for respondents No. 3 and 4. He places on record a copy of the communication dated 12.02.2026 addressed by respondent No. 4 to the petitioner, which is taken on record and marked as Exhibit 'X'. By the said letter, it is stated that the administrative approval to the work involved in e-tender notice No. 128 for the year 2025–2026 has been cancelled and, consequently, the entire process of the said e-tender stands cancelled.

2. The present petition was filed for directions to respondents No. 3 and 4 to issue a work order in favour of the petitioner in view of the fact that the petitioner was found entitled to get the said work under
