**FINAL ORDER :**

. Applicants seek to withdraw an amount of Rs. 8,22,044/-  
deposited by the respondent – acquiring body.

2. In the similarly circumstanced matters the claimants were  
permitted to receive 60% of the amount deposited with accrued  
interest. I follow the same course.

3. The civil application is allowed partly. The applicants are  
permitted to withdraw 60% of the amount deposited with accrued

interest on furnishing undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. Balance amount shall be invested in any nationalized bank. The civil application is disposed of.
