1 Heard the learned counsel for the parties. Perused the applications.

Application for condonation of delay:

2 This is an application for condonation of delay of 129 days caused in filing the first appeal.

3 For the reasons stated in the application, the delay stands condoned. The application stands allowed in the interest of justice.

Application for withdrawal of amount:

4 This application is for withdrawal of the amount deposited by the appellant in this Court as per the impugned judgment and award.

ORDER

- I. The applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount out of the amount deposited by the appellant in this Court, with accrued interest thereon, on furnishing usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. The remaining amount be kept in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank till disposal of the appeal.
