APPLICATION FOR DELAY

1. Heard.
2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 46 days caused in filing the first appeal.
3. Perused the application. For the reasons stated therein, it appears that the delay is occasioned on account of administrative exigency. Hence, sufficient cause is made out to condone the delay. The application deserves to be allowed in the interest of justice as the delay is neither deliberate nor intentional.
