PER COURT :

1. Not on board. After mentioning, taken on board.
2. This application is filed for condonation of delay for restoration of the Second Appeal (Stamp), which was dismissed in view of the conditional order passed by the Registrar dated 26.11.2025.
3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that he could not list the appeal before the learned Registrar (Judicial) for removal of the office objections, hence by conditional order dated 26.11.2025, the directions were issued to remove office objections within a period of two weeks, Hence, the applicant submits that the

office objections could not be removed due to inadvertence, the delay may be condoned and the Second Appeal (Stamp) may be restored to its original stage.
