1 This application is filed for condonation of delay, setting aside abatement and permission to bring the legal representatives of deceased claimant Bhagwanrao Gutte on record.

2 Perused the application. There is delay of 379 days caused in filing this application.

3 For the reasons stated in the application, the application deserves to be allowed as the delay is not caused deliberately and intentionally. Hence, the delay is condoned. Abatement is set aside. Permission is granted to bring the legal representatives of deceased claimant Bhagwanrao Gutte on record, on condition that in any case, the appellant shall carry out the necessary amendment, within a period

of two weeks from today i.e. on or before 15th April, 2026. The civil application stands disposed of.

4 It is clarified that, if the amendment is not carried out on or before 15th April, 2026, then the appellant will require to deposit costs of Rs.2000/- with the High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Aurangabad.
