1. Heard Mr. Shaikh the learned counsel for the applicant, at length.
2. Despite service, the non-applicant failed to appear in the matter.
3. By the present application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, the applicant / wife is seeking transfer of H.M.P. No.2168/2022 under Section 13(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, filed by the non-applicant seeking decree of divorce and pending on the file of learned C.J.S.D., Kalyan to the file of learned C.J.S.D., Bhusawal.
