PER COURT :

1. After being heard for some time, when this Court was not inclined to entertain the writ petition against the order directing a 20% deposit of interim compensation under Section 143-A of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to withdraw the present writ petition.
