4. The Petitioner has already furnished an undertaking dated 12.3.2026 to Goa State Urban Development Agency, Government of Goa.

Dr. Rao, learned Senior Advocate, on instructions, makes a statement that on receipt of the aforesaid three amounts from the Goa State Urban Development Agency, the Petitioner would renew the Bank Guarantee earlier issued in favour of the Goa State Urban Development Agency within a period of two weeks and the same shall be kept alive.

6. In view of this statement, Contempt Petition stands disposed of.
