1. Heard.
2. The Appellant–Wife and the Respondent–Husband are present before the Court. The matter was referred for mediation. The Mediator’s report has been received, wherein it is recorded that the parties, namely the Appellant–Wife and the Respondent–Husband, have arrived at amicable settlement and have decided to seek dissolution of marriage by a decree to be passed on mutual consent.

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3. In view thereof, the Appeal is partly allowed. The order passed by the Family Court, Sangli, in Petition A No. 263 of 2020 is set aside and the matter is remitted back to the Family Court, Sangli. The parties have agreed to amend the original petition and to seek a decree of dissolution of marriage in terms of the settlement arrived at between them.

4. In the aforesaid terms, the Family Court Appeal is partly allowed.
