The present Revision Application has been preferred by the Applicant challenging the judgment and order passed by the learned Sessions Court whereby the conviction recorded by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gadhinglaj, came to be confirmed. It is further submitted that, as the Applicant remained absent before

the Appellate Court, the Appellate Court directed the learned JMFC, Gadhinglaj, to issue a conviction warrant against the Applicant.

2. It appears from the record that, since the filing of the present Revision Application, the Applicant has remained continuously absent before this Court. The sentence imposed upon the Applicant has not been suspended. It further appears that the Applicant has not been taken into custody till date, as the conviction warrant has not yet been issued. The Respondent is personally present before this Court, having learnt about the pendency of the present Revision Application through the Court website. The record further reveals that the Applicant has not remained present before this Court since the year 2025.

3. In the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present Revision Application. The Revision Application is accordingly **dismissed**.

4. Learned JMFC, Gadhinglaj, is directed to forthwith issue a conviction warrant and take necessary steps to secure the custody of the Applicant in accordance with law.

4. The Revision Application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
Consequently, the Interim Application, if any, also stands **disposed of**.
