1. Heard Mr. Chavan, learned Counsel for the Petitioner, Mr. Kalel, learned AGP, for the Respondent-State, Mr. Jagtap, learned Counsel for Respondent No.2 and Mr. Narvankar, learned Counsel for Respondent No.3.
