1. By this interim application, the Applicant seeks withdrawal of the remaining compensation amount. It appears that the Applicant has already been paid 50% of the total compensation amount. Thereafter, the Applicant was again permitted to withdraw Rs. 13,25,027/-, and the remaining amount of Rs. 13,25,027/- is lying deposited in a nationalized bank at the instance of the MACT, Khed.

2. The contention is that the Applicant requires an amount of Rs. 3,50,500/- for surgery relating to a crush injury to the left foot. The certificate of doctor has been placed on record.
