1. After arguing the matter for some time, Mr. Saraogi, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioners, submits that he has instructions to withdraw both Writ Petitions. However, he requests that the issues raised in the Writ Petitions be allowed to be raised at the hearing of the Criminal Appeals pending before the learned Sessions Judge.

2. Accordingly, both the Writ Petitions are allowed to be withdrawn and are dismissed as such, with liberty granted as aforesaid.
