1) Ms. Pal, learned advocate appearing for the respondent submits that the mediation process between the parties has failed. Therefore, the matter has to be heard on merits.

2) It is the case of the applicant that the respondent-husband has filed divorce proceedings before the Civil Judge Senior Master, Pune seeking transfer of the said proceedings to the Civil Judge Senior Master, Panvel. She has filed a petition under Section 9 of the restitution of the conjugal rights before the Civil Judge Senior Master, Panvel. So also, she has filed DV proceedings before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Khalapur. The distance between Panvel to Pune

is around 120 kms and the travel time is around three hours by one way. There is no male member in the family of the applicant who could accompany her to attend the court proceedings at Pune and return back on the same day.
