Interim Application No.14782 of 2024 seek condonation of delay of 111 days in filing the Family Court Appeal being aggrieved by the impugned Judgment dated 4th April 2024 passed by the Family Court, Mumbai at Bandra in Petition No. A-1845 of 2021, thereby dismissing the petition filed by her seeking dissolution of the marriage
