1. This is an Application seeking relaxation of condition No. 4 imposed in the order dated 28th January 2022 passed by the Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court at Esplanade, Mumbai. The said condition reads as thus:

“Applicant/Accused shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”
