- “ 1. *By consent of the Petitioner and Respondent No. 2, Larsen & Toubro Limited, the disputes forming part of the subject matter of the present Writ Petition are hereby referred to arbitration as per Clause 18 of the Terms and Conditions of the Work Order. The said clause mandates arbitration in terms of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 to held at Chennai.*
2. *The parties have mutually agreed to the appointment of Hon'ble Mr. Justice M. Govindaraj (Retd.) Madras High Court as the Sole Arbitrator, who is based in Chennai, to adjudicate the disputes which form the subject matter of the present proceedings.*
