2. Mr. Dighe, learned Counsel for the Respondent – Corporation opposed the Petition.

3. We find the request made by the Petitioner that the Commissioner to decide the representation dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2025 within a period of 8 weeks from the communication of the order is reasonable.

4. The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Principal's cabin and two other rooms are under attachment. The Petitioner is willing to deposit the sum of Rs. 10 Lakhs with the Respondent – Corporation without prejudice to his rights and contentions in the representation to be decided. The sum to be deposited within a period of two weeks from today.

5. Considering the statement of the Petitioner to deposit the amount, attachment of Principal's cabin and other premises belonging to the Educational Institution to be lifted. No coercive action be taken against the Petitioner till the representation of the Petitioner is decided. The attachment, if in operation to be lifted subject to the Petitioner

complying with the aforesaid condition, immediately from the date of deposit.

6. At this juncture, the Petitioner does not press for any other reliefs and the same will be prayed at the appropriate stage, after the decision of the representation.

7. With this liberty, the Petition is disposed of.
