1. We have heard the learned Advocate for the Petitioner. Learned Advocate Shri Dhumal appears on behalf of the Sinhgad Technical Education Society- Respondent No. 7. We find that the issue raised by the Petitioner is identical to the issues brought before this Court by the Petitioners in **Writ Petition No. 6765 of 2018** and group of connected matters (**Suman Sachin Jain and Others vs. The State of Maharashtra and Others**).
