6. It appears that, the parties have amicably resolved the dispute and Consent Terms have been executed voluntarily. It does not appear that there is any coercion or duress. The parties are identified by their respective Advocates.

8. In view of the Consent Terms 'X', the petitioners – original plaintiffs withdraw the present writ petition unconditionally.

9. The petition stands disposed in accordance with the Consent Terms 'X'.

10. The undertakings given in the Consent Terms 'X' are accepted as the undertakings to the Court.
