P.C:

1. A suit for partition and separate possession between private individuals is pending before the Trial Court. The rights of the Petitioner, to the extent of shares in the property, have not been crystallized. On this premise, a Writ of Mandamus cannot be issued against a statutory authority.
2. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner submits, on instructions, that all contentions be kept open before the Trial Court in view of the pleadings, and that the Petitioner desires to withdraw this Petition.

3. In view of the above, this **Writ Petition is disposed off** as withdrawn, on instructions.

4. Needless to state, since the suit for partition and separate possession is pending, all claims, rights, and contentions of the Petitioner are kept open.
