1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned AGP appearing for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4 – State.
2. This Petition is for direction to expedite the Revision Application along with the Application for stay which was filed on 27th February 2025. It is the contention of the learned counsel for the Petitioners that no date has been fixed for hearing of the stay Application so far.
