1. Heard the learned Counsel for the applicant.
2. The learned Counsel for applicant submits that, though the Court had expressed its disinclination to entertain the application, he had not sought leave to withdraw the application, and, Para Nos. 2 and 3 of the order dated 23rd December, 2025 be accordingly corrected.
3. The learned Counsel for applicant submits that, he had no instructions to make the statement to withdraw the application.
