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1. This matter has been filed by the Applicant, who is the wife of the Respondent seeking transfer of the husband's Divorce Petition from the learned Family Court, Pune to the learned Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai.

2. Learned Counsel for the Respondent, on instructions of his client submits that the Respondent has no objection, if the proceeding is transferred to the learned Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai.

3. In view of the same, the Miscellaneous Civil Application **stands allowed in terms of prayer clause (a).**

4. The proceeding, being A-1407 of 2025 pending before the learned Family Court, Pune be transferred to the learned Family Court,
