5) Learned counsel for the applicant is hereby directed to convey the order passed today to the 7th Joint Civil Judge Senior Division, Panvel, District Raigad who is hearing the proceedings.

6) Similarly, **Registrar (Judicial-I)** is hereby directed to communicate the order passed today to the **Registrar of the Civil Judge Senior Division, Panvel, District Raigad by E-mail.**

7) At this stage, both the learned advocates submit that they are seeking liberty from this Court to approach the Mediation Centre of District Court at Nashik as parties desire to settle their matrimonial dispute amicably.

7.1) Liberty as prayed, is granted.

8) By consent, following correction is carried out in the order dated 23 January, 2026 :-

8.1) In paragraph no.2, 4th line of the order dated 23 January, 2026, the word 'manager' is replaced with the word 'director'.
