1. The original petition is filed for challenging the order dated 20.10.2018 passed by the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Head Quarter, Pune. The petition was filed in the year 2018. Thereafter, there are subsequent developments and there are further orders passed in August and September 2025. All these

issues are connected issues and, therefore, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that amendment be permitted so that all these issues can be decided together. He is seeking permission to incorporate additional prayers, as well.

- vi) Stand over to 25.03.2026.
