Pasbola, the learned Senior Advocate for the Petitioners, on instructions, craves leave to unconditionally withdraw this Petition.

3. Mr. Tanveer Khan, learned APP for the Respondent/State, does not object to the request for withdrawal.

4. In view of the request made by Mr. Sudeep Pasbola, learned Senior Advocate for the Petitioners, leave granted to withdraw this Petition.

5. The Writ Petition No.3221 of 2025 is dismissed as withdrawn.

At the request of Mr Sudeep Pasbola, learned Senior Advocate for the Petitioners, it is clarified that all contentions of the Petitioners as well as the prosecution before the Trial Court in the case bearing No. PS/3700363/2007 pending before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, 8th Court, Esplanade, Mumbai are left open, to be considered by the Trial Court on its own merits and in accordance with law.
