The petitioner is seeking a direction against ICICI Bank to deposit Rs.5,40,016.80, which is the amount siphoned off from the bank account of the petitioner maintained with the said bank.

4. In view thereof, this writ petition cannot be entertained with the prayer as prayed for, and the same is disposed of with
