1. Heard Mr. Vikas Shivarkar, learned Advocate for the Petitioners and Mr. Tanveer Khan, learned A.P.P. for the State/Respondent.

2. Mr. Tanveer Khan, learned A.P.P. for the State/Respondent submits that the charge-sheet is already filed in the present matter before the Trial Court having jurisdiction.

3. By the present Petition, the Petitioners have sought for the following substantive relief :-
