The petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- a) *Issue a writ of Mandamus to Respondent No. 2 directing them to provide immediate police protection to the Petitioner;*
- b) *Issue a writ of Mandamus to Respondent No. 2 & 3 directing an independent and thorough investigation into the extortion call received from jail premises, and to fix responsibility on officials allowing such illegal communication;*
- c) *Direct the Respondent No. 3 and 4 to submit a status report on the action taken in respect of the FIR lodged by the Petitioner;*
- d) *Direct Respondent No. 4 to transfer the Investigation to Crime Branch since the offence is very serious in nature;"*
