“b) Quash and set aside FIR bearing CR. No. 436 of 2023 registered at Yeola Taluka Police Station, Yeola for the offence’s punishable u/s 498A, 406, 323, 504, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code and charge-sheet dated 19/09/2025 by consent of respondent no. 2.”
