1. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant is the sole bread earner of the family, and considering that he has two other sons-one of them is permanently disabled-are dependent upon him to take care of.

2. Learned counsel for the Respondent No.2 though record no objection for grant of bail, the allegations in the FIR are not reiterated/withdrawn.

3. Considering the nature of allegations and *prima facie* material on record, when this Court has shown its disinclination to grant any relief at this stage, Mr. Shukla, learned counsel for the

4. Bail Application is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed.
