1. This matter was heard for some time.
2. The learned Advocate representing Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 submits that an Appeal can be filed against the rejection of a registration Application under Section 29 of the Maharashtra State Council for Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy Act, 2002 (the Act of 2002), before the State Government in the prescribed manner.
