The petitioner-Trust seeks to challenge Public Tender Notice dated 21st January 2026 as illegal and null & void.

The petitioner-Trust seems to be aggrieved by the action of the respondent-authority which did not obtain NOC from it for organizing various games and installing shops on the occasion of Urus of Pir Karam Ali Shah Baba.
