The challenge in this petition is to an order dated 19th January, 2026, passed by the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee in Appeal No. 252/2025 whereby the appeal preferred by the petitioners against an order passed under Sections 33 and 38 of the Maharashtra Slum Areas

(Improvement, Clearance and Redevelopment) Act, 1971, was dismissed.

3. Mr. Patil, the learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions submits that, the orders of eviction have been implemented. Hence, reserving the right of the petitioners to claim enhanced transit rent, the petitioners do not wish to prosecute this petition.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, the Writ Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn reserving the right of the petitioners to agitate the grievance regarding the enhanced transit rent in accordance with law.
