1 We deem it appropriate to dispose of the Writ Petition without issuing notice to Respondent Nos. 4 to 8 as the Petition seek a limited relief in form of direction to the Divisional Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Mumbai Division i.e. Respondent NO.2 to hear and dispose of Appeal No.A/0121 OF 2025 filed by Respondent Nos.3 to 7 within stipulated period.

2 On hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned AGP representing the Authorities including Divisional Joint Registrar of Cooperative Societies before whom the Appeal is pending , we find that there is no extreme urgency in deciding

the Appeal and the contention of the counsel for the Petitioner that the stay order has been granted on 20/05/2025 thereby staying the effect and operation of the order dated 08/04/2025 passed by Respondent No.2, is not a ground to hear the Appeal out of way.

3 We, therefore, direct that the Appeal pending before the Divisional Joint Registrar in form of A/0121 of 2025 shall be decided as per the sequence in which it has been filed and once it is ready and due for hearing, it shall be decided expeditiously.

4 Writ Petition is disposed of in the above said terms.
