Mr. Mendadkar, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner upon instructions states that he is pressing for only prayer clause (b) of the Writ Petition which is for a direction to the Respondent No.2 – Corporation to decide the representations of the Petitioner dated 24 October 2025, 4 November 2025, 1 December 2025 and 9 March 2026 in light of G.R. dated 22 April 2025 in a time-bound manner.

2. Mr. Sandeep Shinde, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent No.2 - Corporation states on instructions that the General Administration Department of the Respondent No.2 – Corporation will consider the aforementioned representations within a period of eight weeks

from today. This statement is accepted.

3. In view of the above statement, the General Administration Department of Respondent No. 2 – Corporation shall decide the said representations and pass order thereupon within a period of eight weeks from today and communicate the same to the Petitioner within a period of one week thereafter.

4. In the event, the Petitioner is aggrieved by the order passed by the General Administration Department of the Respondent No.2 - Corporation, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to adopt appropriate proceedings impugning the same.

5. Writ Petition is disposed of in these terms. There shall be no order as to costs.

6. We have not considered the merits of the present Petition and all rights and contentions of the parties are expressly kept open.
