1) Learned advocate Mr. Bharat Shinde appeared on behalf of the respondent and seeks a short accommodation in order to file Vakalatnama and his reply.

2) By the present transfer application, the applicant, wife of the respondent is seeking transfer of the divorce proceeding filed by the respondent-husband before the Family Court, Pune to the Family Court at Dharashiv.

3) It is the case of the applicant that she is a home-maker and the respondent is in service and is also running a company viz.,

M/s. L.K. Engineering. The ancestral home of the respondent is at Alni, Taluka and District Dharashiv. The applicant is staying at Dharashiv with her parents. She is suffering from thyroid.
