1. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. The prayers made in the present petition read thus:
"a. This Hon'ble court may kindly be pleased to order urgent maintenance of INR Rs.2,35,000/- in favour of the petitioner till final order by the Ld. Family Court;
b. This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to Direct the Ld. Family Court to expedite the case and decide final maintenance within 06 months;
c. For interim and ad-interim reliefs in prayers (a) and (b);
d. For costs of this petition;
e. Any other such order that this Hon'ble Court may deem fit;"
