Heard Mr. Sudatta Patil, the learned counsel for the petitioners for some time. There is an order of provisional attachment under sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 passed on 16th May 2025. This order of provisional attachment is not under challenge.
