1. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.
2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, submits that the Petitioner is willing to appear before the learned Additional Sessions Judge in Criminal Appeal Nos.48 of 2024 and 47 of 2024. In the meanwhile, the execution of the non-bailable warrants be stayed.
3. In view of the aforesaid statements, the Writ Petitions stand disposed with liberty to the Petitioner to appear before the learned Additional Sessions Judge seized with Criminal Appeal Nos.48 of 2024 and 47 of 2024 on 21 April 2026 and file applications for recall of the non-bailable warrants.
