1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned special prosecutor for respondent No.1 and learned APP for respondent No.2.

2. Learned special counsel for respondent No.1 submits that the applicant is an habitual offender. Two offences under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, are registered against her. The police had to run from pillar to post to arrest her as she was absconding for couple of months and she has destroyed all the evidence against her.
