3. I am inclined to pass the following Order, the Applicant is granted pre-arrest protection on the following terms and conditions:

ORDER

(i) In the event of arrest, the Applicants- Ms. Pranita Sachin Matre and Ms. Chaya Gautam Matre be released on bail in connection with C.R. No.198/2026 registered with Daund Police Station, Pune Rural on 31st March, 2026 under Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 351(2), 352, read with Section 3(5) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 on executing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each, with one or two sureties in the like amount;

(ii) The Applicant shall report to the Investigating Officer of the concerned Police Station on 23rd May, 2026 to 26th May, 2026 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and, thereafter, as and when called for;

(iii) Accordingly, Anticipatory Bail Application No.1312 of 2026 is disposed of.
