1. By these applications, the applicants are seeking relaxation of condition viz. the applicants shall not enter into the territorial jurisdiction of Tal-Purandar, till the conclusion of the trial.

**O R D E R**

(ii) The applicants shall leave Taluka -Purandar on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026 by 6.00 pm.

Interim applications are allowed in above terms and disposed of.
